

Arboretum “Duck Pond” Directions

From I-5 Northbound

Take the Dearborn St./James St./Madison St. exit (#164A)

At the end of the exit, turn right onto Madison St.

Follow Madison for about 2 miles to the Intersection of E. Lake Washington Blvd.

Turn left onto E. Lake Washington Blvd and follow the winding road through the Arboretum, passing under the brick bridge.

Veer to the right, staying on the “low,” winding road. (**DO NOT** turn right towards the Graham Visitors Center)

The road will dead end in a small parking lot just beyond the back gate to the Broadmoor Golf club.

Stay by your car, and Lynette, who drives a red Subaru Forester, will meet you there.

From I-5 Southbound

Take the exit for Hwy 520 (#168B - Bellevue/Kirkland)

Immediately take the first exit (Montlake Blvd./Univ. of Washington) from 520.

From the exit ramp, go straight across Montlake Blvd. onto E. Lake Washington Blvd and follow the winding road into the Arboretum.

Turn to the left at the sign for the Visitors Center, and stay on the “low” winding road (**DO NOT** turn right towards the Graham Visitors Center).

The road will dead end in a small parking lot just beyond the back gate to the Broadmoor Golf club.

Stay by your car, and Lynette, who drives a red Subaru Forester, will meet you there.

From Westbound 520

Take the Lake Washington Blvd. Exit.

At the stop sign, turn left into the Arboretum and follow the winding road through the Arboretum.

Turn to the left at the sign for the Visitors Center, and stay on the “low” winding road (**DO NOT** turn right towards the Graham Visitors Center).

The road will dead end in a small parking lot just beyond the back gate to the Broadmoor Golf club.

Stay by your car, and Lynette, who drives a red Subaru Forester, will meet you there.
